



3. The Central Government Permission will be renewed on yearly basis after verification of the achievement of annual targets. The next batch of students should be admitted in the college only after renewal of Central Government Permission for 2nd year BDS Course in the college.

4. Admissions made in violation of the above condition will be treated as irregular and action under Section 10B of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 will be initiated.
